### SPECIAL ACADEMIC PROGRAMS

**Marine Jr. ROTC Program** - The Marine Corps Junior Reserve Officers' Training Corps program mission is to instill in students in United States secondary educational institutions the values of citizenship, service to the United States, personal responsibility and a sense of accomplishment. Marine Corps core values of honor, courage, and commitment help cadets become all around better citizens. The program encourages physical fitness, leadership and excellence in all areas of the cadets' lives.



**4 Year Band Program** - The award winning Catholic High School instrumental music program offers several opportunities for students including the Pep Band, Wind Ensemble, Jazz Ensemble, Jazz Combo, and the new addition of a Popular Music Ensemble. The groups are comprised of all grades at Catholic High School and rely on the contribution of every member, including students who are new to instruments. The uniqueness of having freshmen through seniors allows for the study and performance of high quality music as well as challenging each student-musician.

**Structured Study Hall (SSH)** - including the Dyslexia/Dysgraphia Program - is taken in place of the standard study hall. SSH equips incoming freshmen with the skills necessary for academic achievement and confidence at the college prep high school level. Students are trained in study habits, organizational skills, academic self monitoring, and self discipline. The small group setting allows for individual assistance and troubleshooting in every subject. Priority enrollment is given to students with greatest academic need. A \$375 fee is assessed per semester.
